The *Fund* is administered by ICD in Merrillville, IN.

The following criteria must be met to be eligible for the scholarship drawing:

- ❖ Applicant must be a high school graduate enrolled in college in the fall semester of 2026 or a college student returning to school in the fall semester of 2026 or spring semester of 2027.
- ❖ Students pursuing trade or vocational programs are also encouraged to apply, provided they are enrolled in a recognized training program for the fall semester of 2026 or spring semester of 2027.
- ❖ Applicant must have maintained, in the past, at least a cumulative 3.0 grade point average and can demonstrate this with a transcript if selected.
- ❖ Applicant must be the child/grandchild of a United Steelworkers member who is currently eligible to participate in the Career Development Program.
